## Rainbow experiment

## RESOURCE SHEET

You will need:

Two small bowls of water
Felt-tip colouring pens
Kitchen roll
Paper clip
Thread


1) Carefully cut your kitchen roll into a shape of a rainbow.
2) Colour a rainbow about 2 cm tall from both sides of bottom of the kitchen roll.
3) Tie the thread around the paper clip.
4) Put the paper clip on the top of the rainbow.
5) Hold the thread up and put both sides of the rainbow into the small bowls of water.
6) Watch your rainbow grow!

## Did you know?

Rainbows normally appear from a mix of rain water and sunshine. They are made up of seven colours - red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet. The sun makes rainbows when sunlight passes through raindrops. The raindrops bend the sunshine and colours and this is what creates a band of colours that make a rainbow.
