



## Painbow experiment

## **RESOURCE SHEET**

You will need:



Two small bowls of water



Felt-tip colouring pens



**Kitchen roll** 



Paper clip



Thread



- 1) Carefully cut your kitchen roll into a shape of a rainbow.
- **2)** Colour a rainbow about 2cm tall from both sides of bottom of the kitchen roll.
- **3)** Tie the thread around the paper clip.
- **4)** Put the paper clip on the top of the rainbow.
- **5)** Hold the thread up and put both sides of the rainbow into the small bowls of water.
- 6) Watch your rainbow grow!

## Did you know?

Rainbows normally appear from a mix of rain water and sunshine. They are made up of seven colours – red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet. The sun makes rainbows when sunlight passes through raindrops. The raindrops bend the sunshine and colours and this is what creates a band of colours that make a rainbow
