The SWaN conference aims to explore how engineering, agriculture, ecology and the water industry can collaborate to maximise the use of nature-based solutions. Grown out of learnings from The Abberton Scheme, a water resources infrastructure project with environment at its heart, the conference will consider the opportunities and challenges that may arise from changes in environmental and agricultural legislation and look at how we can fairly account for all of the costs, including the impacts on natural capital and society.
