Thank you for your letter regarding 2021 Bathing Water Quality and the Outcome Delivery Incentive (ODI).

I understand that you are requesting a factual statement of evidence in connection with bathing water quality specifically for Marsden in the 2021/22 reporting year.

I can confirm that having robustly reviewed the evidence we will be able to provide the factual statement requested. We believe this fits under the exclusion given the conclusions of the deterioration investigation. We support the conclusion that the main cause of bacteria is a local non Northumbrian Water Limited (NWL) source and that the nearby NWL network overflow asset is not to be the cause for the deterioration.

I will request that the statement is drafted and forwarded to James McClean.
